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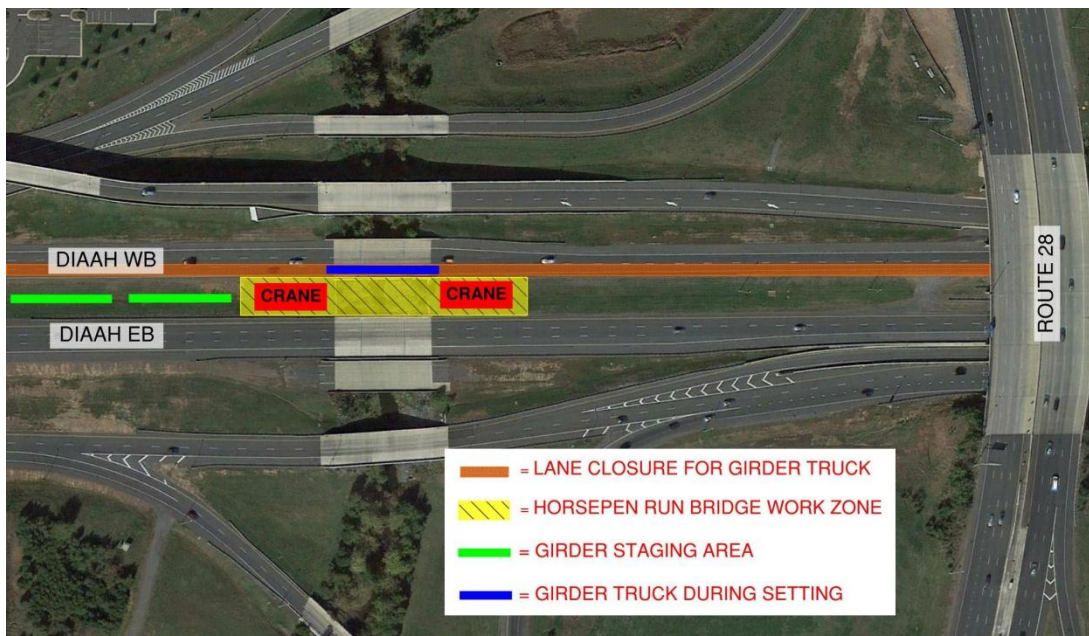
**Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project
PHASE 2**

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Girder Setting at Horsepen Run Bridge

On or about the week of April 6, Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews will set the four girders that will support the Silver Line's Horsepen Run Bridge in the median of the Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) just west of the Route 28 overpass. At 133 feet long and 8 1/2 feet high, the four steel girders will be transported during day time hours under police escort departing Pennsylvania around mid-morning, traveling along Interstate 81 south, Route 66 east, Interstate 495 and the westbound DIAAH, and arriving at the girder staging area in the median of the westbound DIAAH around 2 p.m.

The girders will be set from a lane closure on the westbound DIAAH during daytime hours. Drivers should be attentive to signage and barricades and be alert as large, slow-moving vehicles may be exiting and entering the highway at various times throughout the day time and night time hours.
