Night Work Continues on Autopilot Drive at Washington Dulles International Airport

Utility relocation work on Autopilot Drive at Washington Dulles International Airport, is expected to continue for approximately four to five weeks. Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews are working Sunday through Thursday nights, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Phased single lane closures will occur in the southbound lanes of Autopilot Drive near the Rudder Road intersection. In the northbound lanes, phased single lane closures will occur approximately 800 to 1,000 feet north of Rudder Road and approximately 500 to 900 feet south of Materials Road.

Drivers should be alert to changing conditions and obey all signage and barriers. Access to the car rental lots will be maintained at all times, and flaggers will be in place as needed for safety. All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
