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DULLES CORRIDOR METRORAIL PROJECT

Important Lane Closures for the Week of January 11 - January 17

Road/station work and inspections along Leesburg Pike (Route 7), Frontage Road, Colshire Drive and Dulles Connector Road (DCR) will continue the week of January 11, 2015 and will cause multiple lane closures.

Phase 2 Barrier Installation, Soil Testing, and Other Construction Activities Continue along the Dulles Toll Road, Dulles International Airport Access Highway, Dulles Greenway, and on Airport Roads.

Phase 2 Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews are continuing barrier installation, soil testing, and other construction work. Single lane and shoulder closures will occur along the Dulles Toll Road, Dulles International Airport Access Highway, Dulles Greenway, and on airport roads the week of January 11 - January 17.

This work will take place both overnights and during the daytime hours. Please note that dates and times may change as lane closures can be adversely affected by inclement weather or other elements. Details of the work that will take place this week follow below.



Please see the details for all of these activities as well as other lane, ramp and shoulder closures that have been approved for the week of January 11, 2015. All closures are weather permitting and subject to change. All night shift lane closures will have police escorts onsite for enhanced public safety.

Leesburg Pike (Route 7) East

Friday, January 16, 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

What: Westbound lanes of Route 7 closed

Where: **From Route 123 to Dulles Toll Road**

Why: Water valve inspections

Frontage Road

When: Monday, January 12 - Thursday, January 15, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Friday, January 16, 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

What: North and southbound alternating Frontage Road flagging operation

Where: **From 600 feet east of Route 7 to 200 feet east of Route 7**

Why: Locate test station

Colshire Drive (East)

When: Monday, January 12 - Thursday, January 15, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Friday, January 16, 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

What: Right lane of eastbound Colshire Drive closed

Where: **From Route 123 northbound to 300 feet east of Route 123 northbound**

Why: Concrete bus pad inspections

Dulles Connector Road (DCR) East

When: Monday, January 12 - Thursday, January 15, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Friday, January 16, 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

What: Left thru lane of DCR eastbound closed

Where: **From Chain Bridge Road to I-66/DCR Exchange**

Why: Drainage inlets clean out

Dulles Connector Road (DCR) West

When: Monday, January 12 - Thursday, January 15, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Friday, January 16, 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

What: Left thru lane of DCR westbound closed

Where: **From 500 feet west of Pimmit Run to Chain Bridge Road**

Why: Clean drainage inlets

Dulles Toll Road (DTR) East

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What: Left lane closed

Where: **From mile marker 1.5 to 2.7 (from 3/10 mile past the Route 28 overpass to 2/10 mile past the Centreville Road overpass)**

Why: Barrier installation

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What: Right shoulder closed

Where: **Along the ramp from Route 28 south to the eastbound Dulles Toll Road, continuing to mile marker 1.2 (just before the Route 28 overpass)**

What: Left lane closed

Where: **From mile marker 2.7 to 1.5 (from 2/10 mile before the Centreville Road overpass to 3/10 mile before the Route 28 overpass)**

Why: Barrier installation

Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) East

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What: Alternating right and left lane closures

Where: **From mile marker 0.6 to 2.7 (from the Dulles Greenway ramp overpass to 2/10 mile past the Centreville Road overpass)**

Why: Barrier installation

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What: Alternating right and left lane closures of varying lengths

Where: **From mile marker 2.8 to 6.0 (from 3/10 mile past the Centreville Road overpass to 2/10 mile before the Wiehle Avenue overpass)**

Why: Barrier installation

Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) West

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
What: Alternating right and left lane closures
Where: **From mile marker 2.7 to 0.6 (from 2/10 mile before the Centreville Road overpass to the Dulles Greenway ramp overpass)**
Why: Barrier installation

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
What: Alternating right and left lane closures of varying lengths
Where: **From mile marker 6.0 to 2.8 (from 2/10 mile past the Wiehle Avenue overpass to 3/10 mile before the Centreville Road overpass)**
Why: Barrier installation

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
What: Alternating right and left lane closures
Where: **From mile marker 0.3 to Copilot Way (from 2/10 mile after the Rudder Road overpass, continuing along Saarinen Circle past Daily Garage 1)**
Why: Survey/Road Work

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
What: Left lane closed
Where: **From mile marker 5.2 to mile marker 4.7 (from the Reston Parkway overpass to 4/10 mile before the Fairfax County Parkway overpass)**
Why: Soil testing

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
What: Left lane closed
Where: **From mile marker 3.8 to mile marker 3.5 (from 4/10 mile after the Fairfax County Parkway overpass to 1/10 mile before the Monroe Street overpass)**

What: Left lane closed
Where: **From mile marker 2.3 to mile marker 1.8 (from 2/10 mile after the Centreville Road overpass continuing for 5/10 mile)**

Dulles Greenway East

What: Left lane closed
Where: **From mile marker 10.2 to 10.8 (from 4/10 mile after the Loudoun County Parkway overpass to 2/10 mile before the Old Ox Road overpass)**
Why: Barrier installation

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
What: Partial ramp closure (right side)

Where: **From mile marker 10.5 to 10.7 (from 7/10 mile after the Loudoun County Parkway overpass, continuing along the exit ramp to eastbound Old Ox Road)**

Why: Construction entrance

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What: Right shoulder closed

Where: **From mile marker 9.0 to mile marker 9.4 (from 5/10 mile after the Ashburn Village Boulevard overpass to 4/10 mile before the Loudoun County Parkway overpass)**

Why: Soil testing

Dulles Greenway West

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What: Left lane closed

Where: **From mile marker 10.8 to 10.2 (from 2/10 mile after the Old Ox Road overpass to 4/10 mile before the Loudoun County Parkway overpass)**

Why: Barrier installation

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What: Right shoulder closed

Where: **From mile marker 11.5 continuing along the exit ramp to Old Ox Road**

Why: Soil testing

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What: Left shoulder closed

Where: **From mile marker 10.9 to the Broad Run bridge (from 1/10 mile after the Old Ox Road overpass continuing for 4/10 mile)**

Why: Soil testing

When: Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 16, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What: Left shoulder closed

Where: **From mile marker 9.3 to 8.7 (from 5/10 mile after the Loudoun County Parkway overpass to 2/10 mile before the Ashburn Village Boulevard overpass)**

Why: Soil testing

Airport Roads

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What: Partial ramp closure (right side)

Where: **From the start of the right turn/exit lane from westbound Rudder Road to northbound Autopilot Drive continuing to 400 feet north of the intersection of Rudder Road and Autopilot Drive (near the police/fire station entrance)**

Why: Barrier installation

When: Sunday, January 11 - Saturday, January 17, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What: Right lane closed

Where: **Southbound Autopilot Drive from 450 feet north of the intersection of Rudder Road and Autopilot Drive to 75 feet north of the intersection of Rudder Road and Autopilot Drive**
Why: Barrier installation

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Access to all businesses in the construction areas along Routes 7 is maintained throughout the work periods. Motorists should stay alert, use extreme caution, and be prepared to allow extra time or alter their travel along these roads.
