



Summary of Elevator and Escalator Access

*Phase 1 through Tysons Corner and Reston
September 2006*

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project complies with or exceeds all regulations outlined by the *Americas with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (Section 4.10)* and the *American Society of Mechanical Engineers (Section A17.1-1990) Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators*. Every station in the Metrorail extension has redundant elevators and escalators.

Specifically, access points in and around the stations include the following:
